ABOUT **SCARBOROUGH HEALTH NETWORK**

Across three hospitals and eight satellite sites, **Scarborough Health Network (SHN) delivers exceptional care to patients in one of Canada's most diverse communities.** Our health network is relied upon by vulnerable patients who are often new to Canada, visible minorities, of low-income status, and face a number of socio-economic and culturally prevalent health challenges (such as chronic kidney disease and sickle cell anemia). But with some of our generation's leading physicians, nurses and clinical staff, many of whom represent the vast diversity of the patients we serve, SHN is committed to delivering care that is world-class, inclusive, accessible and compassionate.

OVERCOMING OUR CHALLENGES

Despite our commitment to serving the community with quality health care close to home, **Scarborough's hospitals have long been left behind**. As with all Ontario hospitals, SHN must raise significant funds to ensure we meet our local community share, including 10% of all infrastructure costs and 100% of all medical equipment. At the same time, limited government funding in capital infrastructure compared to other GTA hospitals means urgently needed projects are put on the backburner, and our staff must care for patients in facilities that pale drastically to elsewhere across Toronto. **To set the stage for the leading role we aim to play among Toronto's hospitals, SHN Foundation needs support to update and expand its facilities** and, ultimately, close the growing gap to ensure equitable health care for all of Scarborough.

As a community hospital taking a leading role in the COVID-19 response, SHN is committed to keeping our staff, patients and community safe and healthy — and this includes to all those who participate and support our Foundation events.

Angus Glen Golf Club has outlined extensive COVID-19 protocol to ensure all events taking place at their courses are safe, physically distant and aligned with local, provincial and federal public health guidelines. This protocol has been in place since 2020 and has allowed more than 25 tournaments to safely continue as planned since the start of the pandemic.

In addition to these precautionary measures, SHN Foundation has decided to forgo the evening reception element of this year's golf event and will instead provide take-home meals that participants can enjoy from the comfort and safety of their homes.

Please review the provided overview of the COVID-19 protocol (see aside) — our team is also available to address any further questions or concerns about participating in the 2021 event.

ANGUS GLEN COVID-19 PROTOCOL

- Masks are required to be worn inside our building at all times (this does include the washrooms, and on course washrooms) unless eating or drinking.
- Social distancing is required at all times, and guests are to maintain 6 ft. distance from employees and other guests who are not in their social circle or household.
- Angus Glen is required to keep logs of the name and contact information (including both phone number and Email) for contact tracing purposes in the event an attendee or staff member is found to be COVID-19 positive.
- Golfers are asked to arrive no earlier than 30 minutes prior to tee off.
- Bag drop has been removed from our tournament services to minimize the touch points, in helping ensure the safety of our guests and our staff.
- Golf carts will be staged in the parking lot 6 ft. apart, with vinyl cart dividers installed to separate the driver and passenger.
